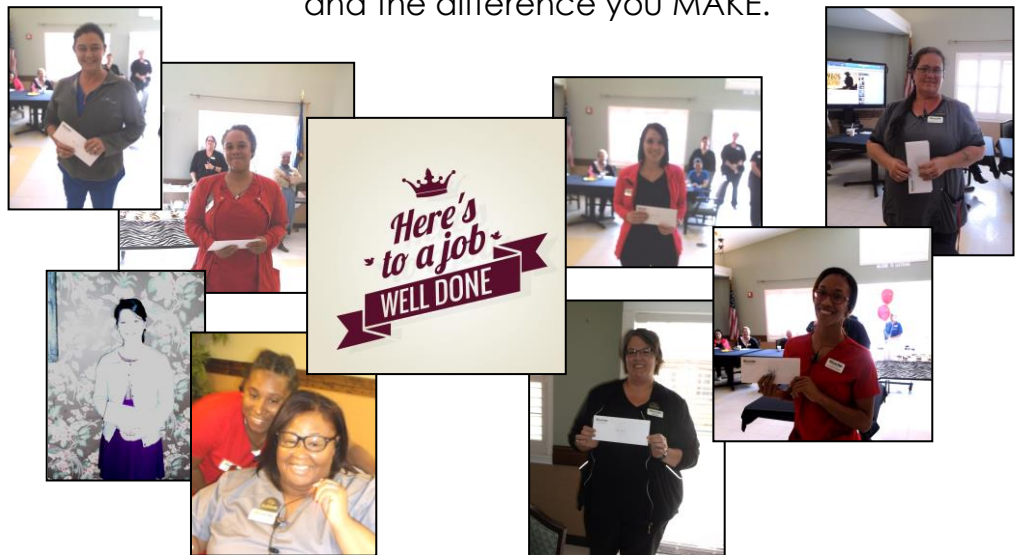
## CONGRATULATIONS, ANN BAUDOIN!

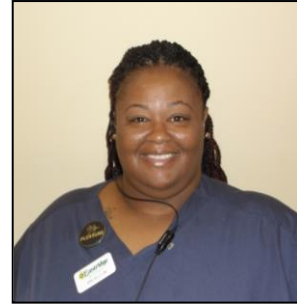
